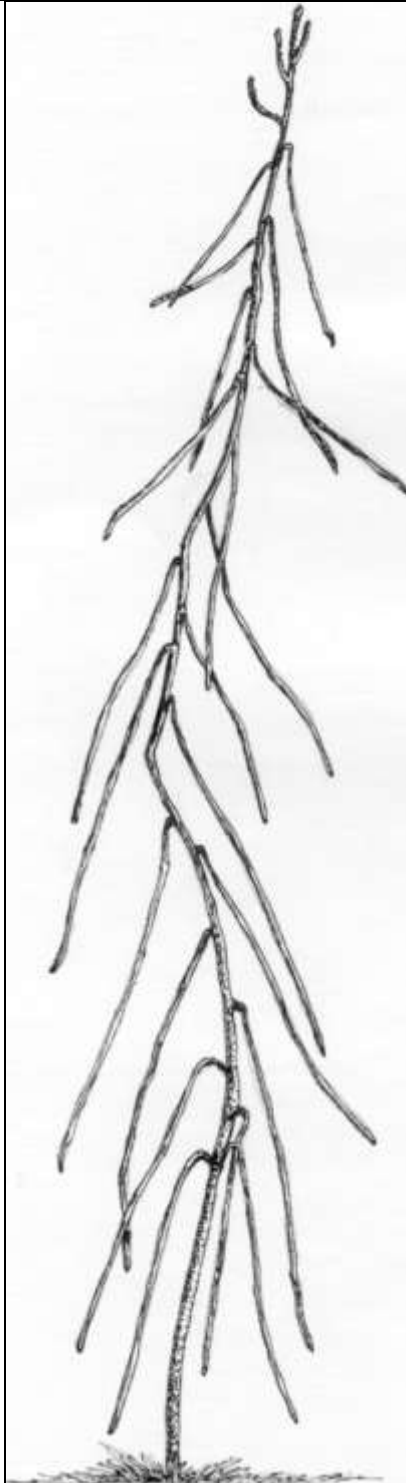

The Day

When: 18 May 2014.

Where: Arena 5 (aka Barber Hall), Waldegrave St, Palmerston North

Time: Doors open at 8-00am for setup. (Timetable attached)

Interclub Table Competition

There is no theme however we are endeavouring to stretch people's minds and skills and are once again asking for 10 items displayed on your table. However the items cannot have previously won a prize and only two pieces can be displayed by any one person.

Size: As usual a standard trestle table will be provided and must be used. This can be used as a table or as the base of your display but the whole display must not extend outside of this floor area.

Cloths: MWG will provide enough green cloth/s to cover the table top but if you wish to provide your own, please feel free. But please stick with say dark green, black or navy without any Guild logo's showing.

Judging Criteria: Will be the same as last year.

Prizes will be awarded for:

- Best Guild Tabletop as per the Judging Criteria. (to be advised)
- Champion Piece
- Runner up piece
- Best Non Turned item (Wellington trophy)

Colt Lathe Competition

To be organised by the Stratford Wood turners

The number of club members required from each guild is ideally 6, but will allow a min of 4.

(By having a minimum of 4 it allows guilds struggling to find six turners the option to have two turners doing both the morning, and the afternoon session.)

Last years winner is responsible for ensuring the trophy is returned on the day for presentation.

Scrolloff

This is an individual challenge as opposed to a Guild challenge. However we would like each Guild to nominate a person or two to enter. This will only take about 15 minutes. It won't be onerous and no-one needs to be very experienced on the scroll saw to cope.

All will be cutting on Delta Scroll Saws There are enough of these machines around now that most people should be able to get access to one beforehand to become familiar with the brand.

Anything else that is needed will also be supplied.

Closer to the time we will be in touch with you to gather numbers of entrants in the Scroll off so we can formalise how many scroll saws we need to organise the event.

5 Minute Mystery Activity

There will be a 5 Minute Mystery Activity featuring general woodworking skills. **It will run by**

Kapiti Guild and there will be three sessions with three different Guilds competing against each other in each session. The three winning guilds will then compete in a final. We require each guild to nominate three entrants. Once again it won't be onerous, just fun!

Trade Stalls and Demonstrators

Demonstrators in various aspects of woodworking will run during the day as in the past and various Trade Stalls will be on site.

Remember he/she who dies with the most toys wins!

Craft Stalls

This year we are looking to run craft stalls in the area that the trade stalls previously occupied. We have booked two halls and the trade stalls/ cafeteria will be re sited in the hall adjacent to the existing hall. This will give us twice the space we have previously had.

Both halls are connected through two open doorways.

If any member of your Guild/Club wishes to set up a stall then they should pre-book a space and this can be done by contacting me Don Tietjens. The cost will be \$50 per stall.

Raffle

With costs rising each year and to avoid any deficit coming out of our Guild coffers we are very dependent on the proceeds of the raffle to offset costs. Therefore it would be appreciated if each guild could provide something for the raffle even mums baking would suffice.

Looking forward to seeing all Guild's / Clubs present again for this ever popular event.
